CALL TO ORDER AND OPENING STATE OF THE ORGANIZATION REMARKS

The Fall Board Meeting of the Arkansas Academy of Mechanical Engineering was called to order at 3:05 p.m. CDT on Friday, October 13th, 2023, by President Mike Anderson. President Anderson opened the meeting by thanking everyone for joining and saying it was a beautiful day in NW Arkansas. We've had a couple of events for the students and we are looking forward to voting on the new member candidates.

APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES

The minutes from the August meeting were not ready and are planned to be presented at the next meeting.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Treasurer Jeff Hayes started by saying that Cristine Wolf has agreed to help with scholarship program management and tracking. Starting with the General accounts report, Treasurer Hayes said that we are now in the first quarter of FY 2024 and we started with a balance of \$317,328. It was not a busy quarter, we had \$1075 in member contributions and \$672 in company matches. One note regarding matching contributions, we have several members that worked for Entergy which is still matching contributions. For expenses and transfers out, we transferred \$1675 to our scholarship account to fund student scholarships. We had some good investment gains of \$5709 and additional interest that totaled to \$5986. The General Accounts Report is shown below.

Moving on to the Scholarship Report, Treasurer Hayes said we've seen a lot of positive growth here. In the investment account, where we've said we are going to leave those funds alone, we have now crossed the point where we have more funds than in the general account. We had \$1575 of member contributions, and we've transferred \$1675 into the spending account to fund scholarships. Then in the scholarship spending account, we had \$10,350 in expenses for fall general scholarships. The Scholarship Accounts Report is shown below.

Cristine Wolf said that we are looking for a volunteer to eventually step in and take over for Jeff as treasurer. Cristine is not taking on any treasurer responsibilities, but is tracking scholarship donations and how they funnel into named scholarships. Remember, if a doner contributes \$5,000 to the named scholarship program, a onetime named scholarship is awarded. Once their donations get to \$10,000, a permanent named scholarship is created for \$500. We currently have four named scholarships of varying amounts. Some members are continuing to add to them. After a member's donations hit \$20,000, the value of the annual scholarship awarded will increase from \$500 to \$1000. The program information we have currently specifies these amounts for \$10k and \$20k donations, but the documentation doesn't specify what happens after that. Cristine plans to update it to state that for every \$10,000 in donations, an increase of \$500 in awarded scholarships will follow.

Cristine asked the board to vote at the next meeting to transfer a member's \$103,000 donation from the General Account to the Scholarship Account. This member previously told Cristine that's what they want, but she has been unable to get back in touch with them to ask for a letter stating such. Treasurer Hayes added that the funds are in the General Investment Account and if we were to make the transfer, that would leave about

\$190,000 in the account. Dr. Nutter suggested that when the language for the named scholarship plan is updated, that after a member contributes \$50,000, that a 2nd scholarship would be created that would go to a different student. Cristine agreed to add this to the new proposed language.

COMMITTEE REPORTS


✓ Finance Committee Report

Chairman Rob Porbeck was not available, and Treasurer Jeff Hayes presented the finance report. Treasure Hayes referenced page 2 of the finance report, and pointed out that the 2023/2024 column shoed income and expenditures through the first quarter of FY2024, and the rightmost column with blue text showed the FY2024 budget. The income and expense graph on page 3 shows that there hasn't been a lot of activity so far this year. The toral funds graph on page 4 really shows how our total funds have grown significantly the last several years. The FY2024 1st Quarter Finance Report and the FY2024 (2023/2024) budget are excerpted below. FY2022 (2021/2022) finances are shown for comparison.

He'd like to expand the mentorship program so that more students can be helped. One thought was that maybe we can help to promote internships. Daniel Wilson has said that he would assist. President Anderson thanked Kyle for taking on the job and thanked Darren Talley for his work the last several years leading this effort.

MECHANICAL ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT UPDATE

Dr. Nutter provided the status for the M.E. Department. The semester is going well, classes are in full swing, the fall STEM fair filled Bud Walton area with over 200 employers participating. Over 60% of the companies were looking for mechanical engineers. Students are enjoying the upgraded M.E. lounge. Two new faculty members have started work and are off to a good start developing classes. Associate Professor Larry Roe is thinking of retiring soon. It was staff appreciate week, Melynda is president of College of Engineering Staff Council, and we did a lot to try to recognize our staff and Melynda put a lot of work into this. We're glad that the federal

shutdown didn't happen, it could've caused some grad students that are paid through federal grants to lose pay. There will be some messaging for the two-day giving drive next week. Monday and Tuesday next week are fall break.

1. Cristine Wolf has volunteered to be a board member next year when 2 members roll off, we will still need one more volunteer.
